### Thank you and a look forward.....

I want to start off this briefing with a big 'Thank You' to all the Parishes who attend one of our six Diocesan Roadshows recently.

We had a total of 74 Parishes represented from all corners of the Diocese and these events provided an opportunity for the various departments of the Curial offices to introduce themselves and give an overview of their respective area.

This was the first time we did the roadshows in this manner, as traditionally they have been a finance focused evening. All our six departments were represented: Safeguarding, Finance, Property Services, Adult Education and Evangelisation, Schools and Colleges and Communications.

We received positive feedback about the way these roadshows were conducted and many people thought it was a good idea as it put a face to the voices at Alexander House and St Ambrose. People now have a much better understanding of who is who and where to go to for various issues and support. We will be running these roadshows annually and I will let you all know nearer the time when and where they will be held in 2018.

### On Track for our new Company.....

We are on-track with plans to change the legal status of Clifton Diocese from a Charity to a Company Limited by Guarantee with Charitable status.

As discussed in previous communications and recently at the roadshows, we are changing the legal structure of Clifton Diocese with effect from 1st January 2018. There will be very little change on a day to day basis, though the new company will be known as Clifton Diocese and not CCDTR.

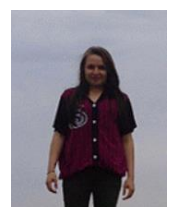
### Alexander House gets Greener.....

Over the last six months our administration offices, Alexander House in Bristol have had a few changes, such as new desks and pedestals. We have now completed an upgrade to the lighting system by installing new LED lighting. These lights are much more energy efficient and work off PIRs so as not to waste unnecessary energy when a room, hallway or toilet is not being used. This energy saving improvement adds to the other recycling initiatives the offices undertakes.

Once registered you will have instant access to all seven modules of the E-Learning programme and will be able to print out your own Certificates of completion.

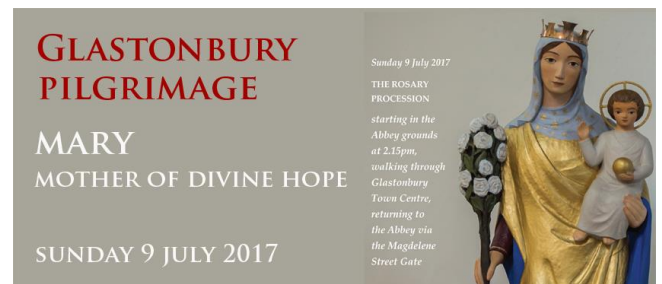

### PILGRIMAGE TO THE HOLY LAND

Planning well ahead, Bishop Declan is set to lead a pilgrimage to the Holy Land in 2018 (22 - 30 October) staying three nights in Galilee, two nights in Bethlehem, and three nights in Jerusalem. Initial costings indicate a figure of £1210 per person (based on two people sharing).



We've always had a superb time in the Holy Land and it'll be good to look forward to another trip in the autumn of 2018.

Interested? Then we're taking initial refundable deposits of £100 (the cost of the flights isn't available until November, so the 'final figure' is dependent upon BA and the flights they release). A booking form is available from the Adult Education and Evangelisation department, and we will keep you updated.

## Baptismal Preparation

Anitra Rawlins has been with the department now for 6 months working with two or three pilot parishes in seeking to implement preparation for baptism and welcoming families into the lives of our communities.
